The Senior Premier Academy focuses on Functional training for specific positions and roles within team systems and formations. This program is directed by USSF and NSCAA nationally certified coaches only. This Academy includes: technical foundation, combination play, principles of attack and defense – as well as Individual, Small Group and Team tactics. All commuters stay until 8:30pm. Senior members play matches each evening. Senior Premier Academy participants will be split into ability-appropriate groups; Teams that register together will train together; and if necessary, other players will be added to fill a team.

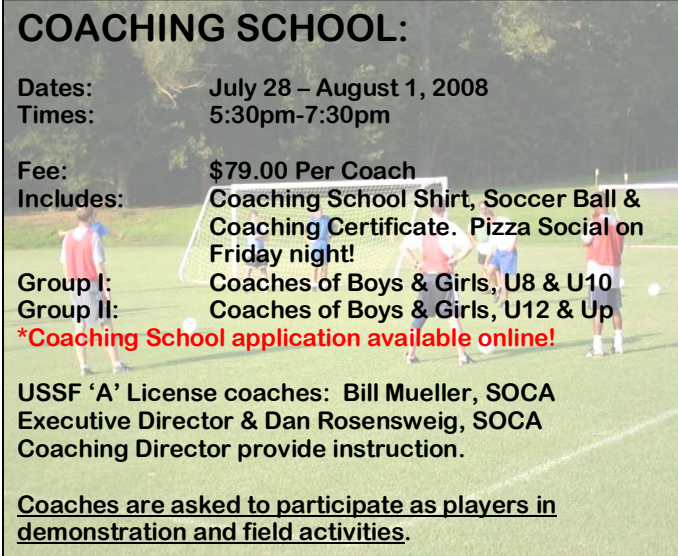
